

## Readiness Review

Kroll Ontrack's **Readiness Review** is a consultancy service that assesses your preparedness to deal with incidents that require the gathering and preservation of digital evidence.

A computer forensic consultant will carry out a comprehensive review of the current capability within your business. As part of the process the consultant will meet relevant parties to understand the high level business needs for computer forensic activity. This will be followed by an examination of the processes and procedures currently in place, plus an assessment of the ability of your organisation to carry out such assignments. This includes a review of any past occurrences of computer forensic work.

At the end of the assessment, you will receive a **Readiness Review** report which details findings and recommendations by identifying best practice, missed opportunities, gaps and shortcomings in existing procedures, remedial actions and training requirements.

## First Responder Training

Kroll Ontrack's **First Responder Training** prepares you to attend incidents that require an effective and efficient gathering of evidence of an employee's IT environment.

This one-day course provides key personnel with an overview of the legal issues involved, computer forensic principles and the processes to be followed, as well as guidance on the key issue of how to ensure evidential integrity. Such evidence may then be subsequently investigated in the knowledge that its integrity is sound.



## Management Awareness Training

## Data Collections

Kroll Ontrack's **Data Collection** service gathers electronic evidence and materials in a forensically sound manner as the foundation of an investigation, or for future use.

Evidence collection is a critical platform for any further investigation and must be carried out in a forensically secure manner by staff experienced and practiced in its collection and "chain of custody" process.

Electronic materials may be collected for cases of suspected misconduct or in support of wider litigation requirements (competition inquiries), mergers and acquisitions, corporate due diligence, company liquidations and as part of an employee exit strategy, to preserve any relevant intellectual property.

## Computer Forensic Investigations

Kroll Ontrack's **Computer Forensic Investigation** service is the process of extracting and analysing digital evidence. It focuses on where the evidence is located, how to access it, understanding what it shows and what to do with it.

The ability to handle digital evidence correctly and defensibly is vital when investigating any case. Our experts employ the correct techniques to carefully and accurately contain, preserve and extract critical evidence. This includes the implementation of a strict "chain of custody" procedure and audit trail throughout the analysis of the data.
